Project Scope

The Noosa North Shore Ecotourism Portal is a unique tourist development on Noosa's North Shore, adjacent to the Great Sandy National Park. The design has taken into account the area's particular environmental sensitivities and has required an extraordinarily high level of environmental input throughout the masterplanning and detailed design phases.

The result is an environmentally sensitive development which has the support of the local community, regulators and council, and which promotes sustainable tourism principles within a high quality bushland environment. A significant portion of the site has been dedicated for conservation purposes and the irrigation water supply and sewerage system is entirely self contained.
